65. STREET LIGHTING STANDARDS

Following circulation (59b/Dec/14) of the Durham County Council revised street lighting policy, which is now in operation, and issues raised by members of the public and of the council regarding the quality of lighting in residential streets, members may consider what stance the town council might take on this issue:

Options available to the committee include:

- a) Noting the position;
- b) Asking Durham County Council for any measurement and evaluation of the light levels in residential streets in the town against the British Standard;
- c) Referring to full council a decision to formally object to the implementation of the current policy on the grounds of public safety.
