The following applications were submitted for consideration:

- (i) DM/15/00183/FPA & DM/15/00184/LB – 22 Bridgegate workshop and store rooms – Listed building consent for conversion of tyre fitting depot to four terraced dwelling houses, including internal alterations to existing adjoining dwelling house.

It was noted that the Town Council had previously supported a similar planning application (Planning Cmt 46(iii)/Oct/11 refers), which had been granted approval by Durham County Council. The three year time limit to begin works had expired, hence the fresh application.
